Here are five excerpts from pizza shop/restaurant reviews. Can you guess what the missing word is? (It is the same word in each case.)

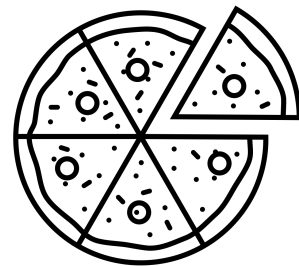
- "If you get a chance, go for lunch. They _____ a really good menu del dia."
